Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The Digital ASF Salon is a format organised by Action Reconciliation Service for Peace in which historical, political and social topics are addressed and discussed in public. Panellists and speakers from different European countries and various professional and societal backgrounds (historians, journalists, politicians, civil society actors, and artists) analyse and debate historical and current issues relating remembrance and civic culture, democracy and participation, discrimination and empowerment. As it is a digital format we can reach, people from all over the World though the salons. Besides the above-mentioned countries, there were participants from Canada, Ecuador, Norway, Ukraine, USA, UK, South Africa and Switzerland.

The format is both informative and participative. It comprises 30-45 minute inputs, which may take the form of presentations, analyses, lectures or literary readings. The audience is encouraged to participate through questions and comments. The subjects under discussion pertain to contemporary issues and debates, and are pertinent to the voluntary and educational activities of ARSP and its European partner organisations. The focus and discussion approach are always designed to facilitate transnational comparative and unifying discourse. For example, the European integration and democracy discourse in the lead-up to the European elections, right-wing extremism and democratic responses at the European and national/regional levels of different EU member states (Italy, Poland, Germany), or the ongoing war of aggression against Ukraine, its historical backgrounds and political implications in and for Europe.

The salons are accompanied by a variety of formats designed to facilitate discussion and participation among different target ARSP and partner groups, including current and former ARSP volunteers, members, donors, supporters, and volunteer sponsors. Examples of these formats include the annual ARSP convention, ARSP study trips, ARSP historical excursions, ARSP "Zeichen" magazine and other publications, ARSP campaigns, both digital and face-to-face, and initiatives such as the "Go vote – for democracy and human dignity!" campaign. The period between March and June 2024 will see the launch of the "Alliance #HandInHand: together against the extreme right!" initiative.
